## 2008 IED SUMMER CAMP REGISTRATION

Summer Hours of operation: 7:30-5:30

Summer at IED is relaxed and fun, with plenty of time for outside play. We'll have weekly themes to explore through the arts throughout the summer, and brush up on soccer skills the last two weeks of August. In addition, children will have time to help in the garden, cook, and play games all summer long. Activities are designed for k (must be 5 years old by June 1<sup>st</sup> 2008) through 5<sup>th</sup> grade. Current pre-k students are welcome. We'll divide into two age groups each morning for different age appropriate activities, coming together at different points in the day for lunch, outside play time, and so on. Three healthy snacks will be offered three times a day.

Children are enrolled on a weekly basis. You may register for any week/s. In order to reserve a spot for your child, please register by May 1<sup>st</sup> 2008. After that registrations will be taken on a space available basis. **We will be closed July 4<sup>th</sup> and July 14<sup>th</sup>-18<sup>th</sup>.**

**Week 1 Fantasy Forest June 23-June 27.** Write and perform a fairy tale. Build a dragon piñata and fairy wings. On wacky wizard Wednesday we make potions and wands. Create clay horns, hairy troll feet and fairy powder. Dragon lovers will not be disappointed!

**Week 2 Clay Days June 30-July 3rd.** Sculpt monsters onto wire armatures. Make a zany self portrait in "mud". How about garden chimes or bells? Come get your hands dirty and have fun!

**Week 3 Intro to Photography July 7-July 11.** You'll be introduced to the workings of a camera, inside and out. See the world with a photographer's eye! We will walk through the nearby blocks utilizing the nature and structures surrounding us. Take candid shots, still life photos, and portraits.

**Bring a disposable 35mm camera for use during this week.**

**Week 4 Garden Art July 21-July 25.** Let your imagination run wild! Campers will make stepping stones, stained glass, bird houses, plant markers and more. Your garden space will be filled with beautiful works of art for the whole family and even the *birds* to enjoy.

**Week 5 Puppet Madness July 28-August 1.** Enter the wild world of puppet crafting. Kids have the opportunity to design and craft shadow, stick and rod, and sock puppets. We will also make a giant dragon puppet over 6 feet tall! Bring your silly hat and create goofy puppet voices to match!

**Week 6 Spare me the Drama! August 4-August 8.** Campers, get ready to show your stuff! Kids will write, direct, make props and sets, design stage makeup and costumes for fabulous production of ??? What will they come up with? Aliens meet Shakespeare? Offstage this week, we'll kick, pass and scrimmage in preparation for soccer season!

**Week 7 DaVinci Days August 11-August 15.** Science and art go naturally together! Learn about rockets, then make one in metal. Recreate natural forms like the horn of the elusive Addax in plaster, or maybe create some "unnatural forms" of your own design. We'll also continue to work on soccer form this week, improving trapping and ball handling skills with fun games.

Weekly Tuition: \$195 (\$156.00 week of 4th of July).

A registration deposit equal to one week's tuition is due with your registration form. This deposit will be applied to tuition for the final week your child attends.

**Please note the following:**

- We cannot pro-rate weekly tuition based on attendance.
- If you must cancel, please notify us no later than 10 business days in advance of the week your child is expected to attend. **If we receive your notification of cancellation less than 10 days in advance, we will not be able to refund your tuition payment. We cannot refund tuition based on non-attendance.**
- Tuition is due 2 weeks prior to start date of the camp week you are registering for.
